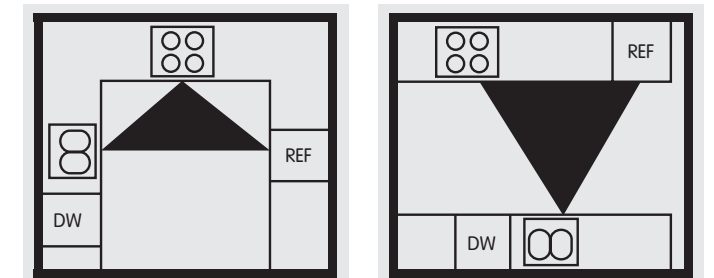
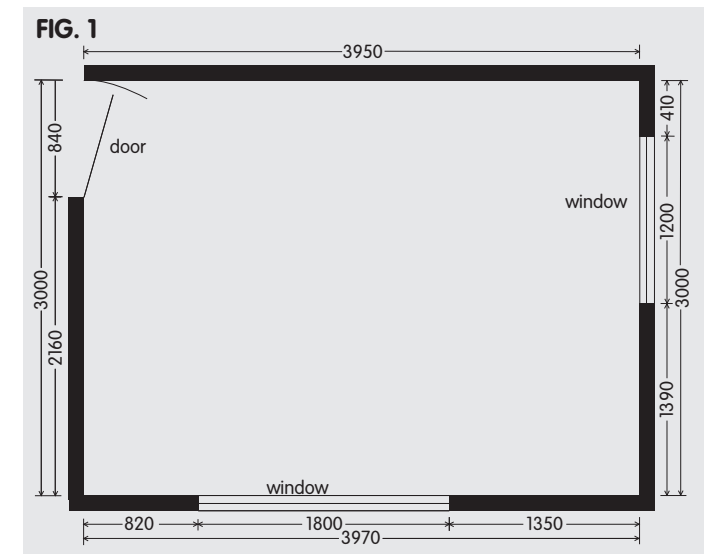
1. Questions before planning Fill out the Barry's questionnaire to help you decide your requirements for your new kitchen.
2. Measure up Accurately measure the internal wall measurements of your kitchen area, taking note of doors, windows, or other openings. Where possible, measurements should be taken approximately 900mm above the floor level. Refer Fig.1)
3. Plan Drawing Using the graph paper draw the wall outline including doors and windows. Always draw the full kitchen area to scale. One large square of the graph paper equals 200mm to scale (1:20)
4. Layout The basic layouts for kitchens are shown to help you decide the kitchen that best suits your requirements. Make a selection.
